



SPANISH UGT CONDEMNS THE WAR AGAINST IRAQ

The Unión General de Trabajadores from Spain totally condemns the war against Iraq, launched by the United States of America, the United Kingdom and Australia, with the support of the Spanish government.

A war decided against the United Nations resolutions and with the only goal of increasing the hegemonic dominion of the United States in the Middle East. A war imposed by the lowest interests of controlling the oil reserves of Iraq, a war that has nothing to do with the defence of Human Rights, as they argue. A war, that will bring more hunger and havoc to the already battered Iraqi people.

Spanish UGT, which has been mobilising the Spanish workers together with many other social organisations (more than 5 million people in the anti-war demonstration of February the 15th), will go on promoting and taking part in all the actions which may be useful to stop this unfair war.

On the 20th there has been concentrations in the most important Squares of the major Spanish cities and we have participated in the delivery to the Parliament of 2 million signatures in favour of peace. On the 21st we will gather in front of the United States embassy in Madrid, for a new demonstration. On the 22nd we will go on mobilising for mass gathering acts of protest...

In those moments of uncertainty we want to send to our Arab brothers a message of respect, solidarity and friendship. Now more than ever we must go on working together, as we have done up to now, in favour of peace, justice and democracy.
